

Where to eat...

Alcossebre and Las Fuentes have many restaurants serving a wide variety of different cuisine from the traditional foods of Spain like Paella and Zarzuela to Chinese, German, Swiss and Italian cuisine.

A very good meal with wine as a "Menu del Dia" would cost around €12-15, or you can find a more up market Restaurant, then the price is up to you, but around €30 is a good guess. This is a selection of Restaurants that we feel are constantly good, they are not in any order of preference just all serving good food over the whole price range. Some of which are:-

Benimar is situated on the promenade between Alcossebre and Las Fuentes. This restaurant serves dishes with a Swiss twist. One of the better restaurants and our own favorite.

Casa Antonio

Town centre, new for 2011, good reputation, perfect for a snack and a drink, food is also good.

Cheers - English Bar serving good reasonably priced food, very good English breakfast. At the Marina close to L'Illa. Sport Bar style. Popular place for watching football.

Chinese restaurant-opposite to SPAR (almost) in the Alcossebre center. Value for money, summertime they serve a buffet which is quite good.

Cordero d'Oro - Restaurant close to the Marina, famous for steak, pork and lamb dishes. Closed on Sundays and Mondays.

El Jardin - Pizzeria in the Alcossebre center on a little side road, good pizzas, also take away.

El Mirador - Seafront restaurant overlooking Romana beach, on the south side of ALcossebre.

El Pinar - it is **THE** Restaurant-with spectacular view in the mountain top village of the same name, just follow the signs on road to Marcolina. Excellent Spanish menu, try the fish or Paella, or just a dessert outside. Daytime visits will probably give you the best views.



L'Illa Restaurante Asador by the marina and they have the most fabulous sea food and steaks. If you like pate you have to order the starter selection you get a huge portion and it's the best pate ever. Nestor - the boss - has many good wines, just ask him. Closed on Wednesdays. Closed in November and May for 3 weeks. A personal favorite!

Loli Taperia down by the marina in Las Fuentes is a great favourite for tapas.

Los Gatos down by the marina is excellent value and great service. You are supplied with free tapas all night, titbits to nibble on like salted peanuts, tostadas etc.

Mare Nostrum and El Patio are the places to go for pizza. Both are situated in the main town of Alcossebre and also have other Italian specialties on the menu. We prefer Mare Nostrum portions are generous, in our experience staff are warm and friendly. Town centre restaurant on the corner of SPAR. Serving a varied menu including excellent pizzas that you can watch being prepared! Particularly good for families.

Mani is a traditional Spanish restaurant on the front, the menu of the day is great value.

Bar La Maya - "Mayas - " is a modest looking place but don't miss out as it's a real catch. If you like authentic tapas, you'll love this place. Very popular beach front tapas bar, worth queuing for a table. A good place and our personal favorite for a tapas lunch meal like "Pan de tomate" (tomatoes on bread), sliced ham, cheese, garlic shrimps, chippriones (small fried squids) rounded off with a coffee!

Restaurant 21 in between Alcossebre and Las Fuentes is more upmarket, great for a treat. the menu and the food live up to the price.

Sancho Panza - Slightly more formal high quality restaurant, a place for that special meal!

Taberna - Next to Santander Bank, a yellow tent outside, good tapas, lunch style.
